Greetings in Christ Jesus, the Shepherd and Bishop of our souls.


We trust you have been experiencing the length and breadth and height of the love of God, for such has been our prayer for you. Our strength has been in the name of the Lord.

Our children seem to have quite an impression, as they have now been invited to go over and visit at Christmas time!
